

The Vault belonging to the Verney-Family is and the Chancel & the way down to it is under the Floor Stones on the top of the Middle Isle. Some changed to North side of Chancel in the Churchyard. The Bodies deposited there are as follows & since a staircase has been made from the adjoining Vestry Francis Peter Verney son of said Willoughby de Broke died 13th July aged 2 months 1772..

X Francis Verney died 3rd Dec. aged 18 months 1778. - The Body of a still born son of the Rev. R. Barnard & Louisa his wife 14th July - 1796. born at Churchgate near the old manor house N.B. The way into the family-vault being found inconvenient it was altered & put on the outside under the North Wall of the Chancel in the year 1798.

April 12th 1798. She kept her Lady with child - deliv'd in the 61st year of her age; died in London the 2nd Instant.

At the same time the Bodies of six of her Children were moved from a Vault under Lady's Chapel & put into this vault viz:

- Sarah Verney. aged 7 months died Decr - 67.
- Louisa Verney. - 4 years - April - 68.
- Mary Verney. - 8 months - March - 72.
- Geo: Peter Verney - 10 years. - June 73.
- W^m: Verney - 9 years. - Sept. 83.
- Hermitha Verney - 6 years - Feb. 84.

The Parish Church was renovated after the Restoration on Aug 10 1876: and the Vestibule to the Vault is now on the North side of the Chancel outside in the Churchyard (see the opposite Page line 4)

The last interment in the Family Vault of the Verney family was that of Georgiana Jane Lady Willoughby de Broke, widow of Robert John Verney, Lord Willoughby de Broke, 16th Barr. above mentioned - Buried on the Vault was then finally closed -
